Section 5.3.8 on Doghouses and Other Pet Shelters, as of <date>, supercedes item 5-11 of First River Farms Rules and Regulation as June 20, 2016.

5.3.8 Doghouses and Other Pet Shelters

- a. Doghouses and other pet shelters, both permanent and temporary, are allowed in a resident's backyard only. No pet shelter of any kind, regardless of size or material, is allowed in the front (or side) yard.
- b. Doghouses, cat shelters, litter boxes or any other structure supporting household pets within a fenced backyard may be of any material, type and color, and may not extend above fence level.
- c. In backyards with no fence, permanent doghouses or other permanent pet shelters must be painted or stained to match the exterior trim of the home. (Residents are reminded that pets must be kept on lead when outdoors and not within the confines of a fenced yard. See Section 5.5.3.)
